Other pictures will be used in fliers, advertising and more. Photos will be displayed in an art exhibit and prints may be sold as fundraisers. All photos will become the property of Carbon County Library System.

Photos should be taken in Carbon County. New and old photos are accepted. Outdoor, indoor, scenery, wildlife, people and objects are allowed. Full color and black & white are both allowed. Pictures which include identifiable people must include a release form by the person in the picture.

Photos must be digital copies in .tiff file format with a 300 dpi minimum resolution with a highest quality setting. You may email images to carbonlibraries@gmail.com with "Picturing the Library" in subject line, please include your name, the photo title. Release of Image form may be turned into any library location by Tuesday, June 1.

Only photos that have releases will be considered. Stop by your local library or carbonlibraries.org for release forms!

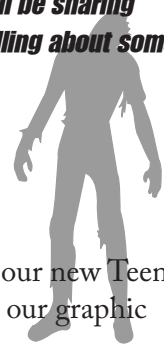
