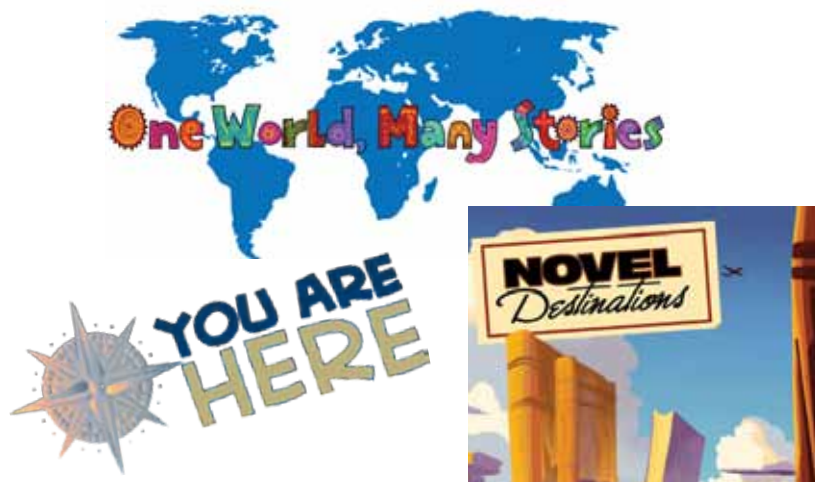

#### **The 2011 Summer Reading Programs**

##### **Many Worlds, One Story (Kids 0-12)**

Kids read up to 20 hours in 15 minute increments for prizes at the 5 hour, 10 hour, 15 hour, and 20 hour levels.

##### **You Are Here (Teens 11-18)**

Teens read up to 15 hours in 15 minute increments for prizes at the 5 hour, 10 hour, and 15 hour levels. Teens that complete 15 hours of reading will be entered into a drawing for a book gift certificate package.

##### **Novel Destinations (Adults 18+)**

Adults do six reading-related activities to receive a prize and be entered into a drawing for Wreck This Journal by Keri Smith and a travel mug.
